Overview

Your plugs will typically stay dormant for 1-4 days if kept in the closed box in a cool, dry area away from the sun. This could be in an unheated garage or a polyhouse. Once you're ready to plant them, take them out of the box and plant them as usual. Transplant your plugs within one week of receipt. Our greenhouse experts do a fantastic. AFTER PLUG RECEIPT Store plugs when received in a sheltered location out of wind and sun. Hydrate plugs by immersing the plugs in water deep enough to cover the plug soil; hold under water until air ...

Allow plants to acclimate to the greenhouse conditions for 24 to 48 hours before transplanting. Water the plug trays thoroughly 2 to 3 hours before transplanting; this aids in removing the plugs from the trays. ...
