The voltage range for Belize is 110/220V, while the standard frequency is 60Hz. The power supply is inconsistent throughout the country and some locations run power at. In Belize, types A & B are the official standard. The standard voltage is 110 / 220 V at a frequency of 60 Hz. 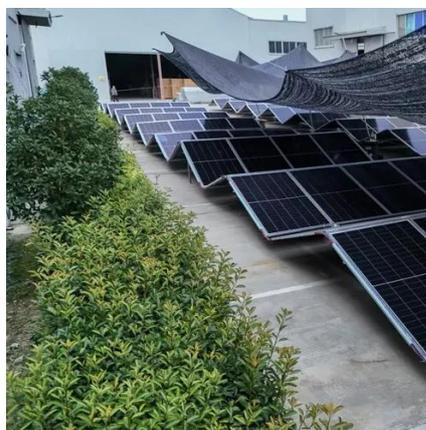

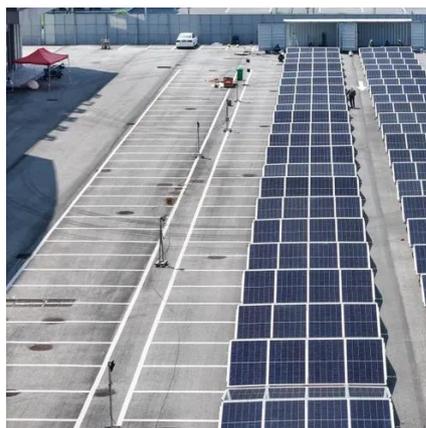
