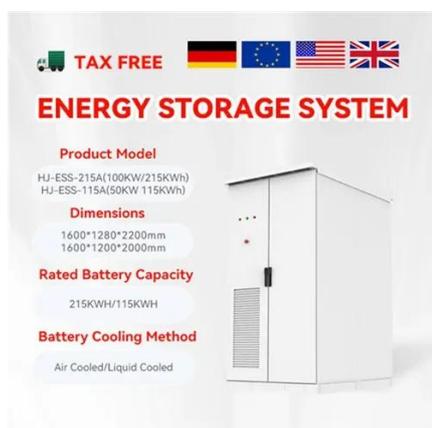


Overview

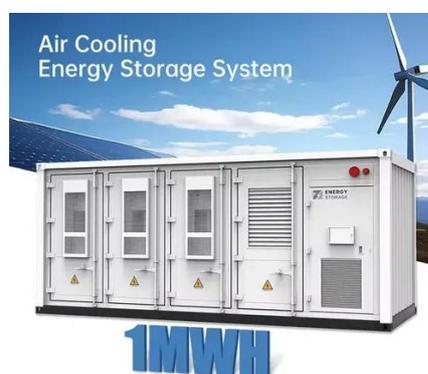
How to Take Apart a Watch

To successfully disassemble a watch, you'll need a few essential tools that guarantee precision and safety throughout the process. Start with precision screwdrivers, which come in sets with color-coded

Once you have the necessary tools, the first step is to remove the back cover of the watch. Use a flathead screwdriver or specialized case opener to carefully remove the back cover. 

